NOTIFICATION**Ph.D PROGRAMME FOR THE YEAR- 2022-23**

Applications in the prescribed form in two sets are invited from eligible candidates for admission to Ph.D Programme in Mangalore University P G departments/ Constituent Colleges/ Recognized Research Centres/Colleges having affiliation for Ph.D Programme for the year 2022-23.

Prescribed application forms along with the detailed notification may be obtained from the concerned Departments, Mangalore University, Mangalagangothri-574199, or the Principal, Field Marshal K M Cariappa College, Madikeri or the Principal University College, Hampankatta, Mangaluru D. K on payment of Rs. 1,100/- (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred Only) (Rs.550/- for SC/ST/CAT-I candidates on production of Caste certificate) through Challan or D D of any Nationalized Banks drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, Mangalore University.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Candidates for admission to the Ph.D programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

Foreign students, including those applying through their Govt. agencies/embassies should contact the respective department in which they intend to register for the Ph.D Programme, to get clearance from the Department Council concerned through the Director, International Student Centre of the University.

2. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation in grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/CAT-I (non-creamy layer)/ differently-abled and other categories of candidates or for those who had obtained their master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991 as per UGC norms. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying examination marks without including any grading.
3. Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. Programme with course work, with atleast 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) are eligible to register for Ph.D Programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ CAT-I (non-creamy layer)/ differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per UGC norms.

4. Candidates possessing a degree considered equivalent to M. Phil. Degree with course work of an India/Foreign educational institution shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D Programme (please see clause 1)

7. The seats vacant under H K Quota shall be allotted to other categories as per rules.
8. 5% seats are reserved for the differently abled candidates outside the intake as per the Government Order.
9. The seats falling vacant under any reserved categories (except SC/ST) shall be transferred to other reserved categories or GM pool as per the rules.
