

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

Proceedings of the meeting of IQAC Advisory Committee held on 11-08-2021 at 3.00 PM in the Syndicate Hall, Administrative building, Mangalore University, Mangalagangothri.

The Chairman of the meeting, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, welcomed the members. He briefed about the NAAC Accreditation results and invited the Director to present the reports.

Agenda 1: NAAC Accreditation Results

The Director (outgoing) of IQAC, Prof. Kishori Nayak K, explained the problems faced during the Data Validation and Verification process and the Appeal process. Also, she outlined the different factors that lead to the grade secured in the third cycle of NAAC Accreditation and added suggestions for improvements to be made for the proposed reassessment to be undertaken by the new team, notified.

Agenda 2: Approval of AQAR 2019-20

As per the IQAC guidelines, the information/statistics pertaining to AQAR 2019-20 were collected from various departments, chairs, administrative sections, and PG Centre, Chikka Aluvara. The information was compiled, and the prepared AQAR was presented before the IQAC.

The draft report was approved for submission with minor modifications. It was decided to place the approved draft of the AQAR in the Syndicate meeting to be held on 27-08-2021 for approval by our statutory body, as required by NAAC.

Agenda 3: Annual Report of IQAC 2019-20 and 2020-21

The activities carried out by the IQAC were presented to the members, and tabled.

Agenda 4: Any other matter, with the permission of the Chair

Collection of information from various departments/sections to prepare AQAR
 The Director highlighted the difficulties faced while collecting data from the departments/administrative sections with the Vice-Chancellor and requested to take appropriate action in this regard.

Decision: The Vice-Chancellor suggested appointing a director Academics to handle these kind of issues in the future.

Some of the suggestions made in the course of discussion to improve the AQAR:

- Shri Prakash Kalbavi suggested including the covid related measures like digitized systems, digital classrooms, webinars, and training programs for faculty to cope with teaching during the pandemic time. He also suggested to hold brainstorming sessions on how to produce future-job-ready candidates.
- It was suggested to include only newly added programmes to programmes/courses focussed on employability/entrepreneurship/skill development.

Other suggestions to improve future performance for AQAR/SSR:

- Coordination of AQAR and AISHE data parameters.
- Encourage startups for entrepreneurship
- Conduct of skill development program and value-added courses

The meeting ended with an expression of thanks to all the members for their participation and co-operation.
