

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



MANGALORE UNIVERSITY, MANGALORE
AND
MANGALORE INSTITUTE OF ONCOLOGY,
MANGALORE

This memorandum of understanding made on the 17th day of February 2016 between Mangalore University, Mangalagangothri, Karnataka (hereinafter referred to as Mangalore University) and Mangalore Institute of Oncology, Mangalore, Karnataka (hereinafter referred to as Mangalore Institute of Oncology) witnesseth as follows:

Preamble

Mangalore University is a public institution established by the Government of Karnataka to promote higher education and research activities. At present, Mangalore University is offering many post-graduate courses in science, commerce and arts and is also conducting research programmes in all these areas. Mangalore Institute of Oncology was established in the year 2010 to provide medical treatment to persons suffering from cancer by providing medical assistance through its expert professionals. Mangalore Institute of Oncology is also interested in initiating teaching and research activities related to cancer diagnosis and therapy. In addition to the on-going courses, Mangalore University is planning to start new post-graduate course in Medical Physics (M. Sc. in Medical Physics). This proposed course needs infrastructural facilities and professional expertise available in Mangalore Institute of Oncology for conducting internship and training programme of M. Sc. and research students. Mangalore Institute of Oncology is also interested in initiating teaching and research programmes in collaboration with Mangalore University. Therefore, to establish a



mutually beneficial relationship built on academic and scientific cooperation, Mangalore University and Mangalore Institute of Oncology wish to promote co-operation between the two institutions in education, training and research.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes the following

I. Scope of MoU

To establish a mutually beneficial relationship built on academic and scientific cooperation between **Mangalore University** and **Mangalore Institute of Oncology**.

II. Period of MoU and its extension

This MoU becomes effective from the day the authorised representatives of both the institutions affix their signatures below, and will continue for an initial period of five years, whereupon it shall be reviewed and it may be extended by a mutual written agreement of both the institutions. This MoU may be revised through the mutual agreement of both the institutions. This MoU may be terminated by either party upon giving six months written notice with reasons for termination and signed by the Head of the Institution of the notifying party. In case of termination, the on-going internship/training program of the students shall not be affected and allowed to continue and complete the internship/training for the specified time.

III. Field of co-operation

Co-operation between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular:

- i. Mutual co-operation and participation in teaching and training programmes conducted by both the institutes.
