Activities organized by Gender Champions in Mangalagangothri Campus

The **theme of the painting competition was “Ushering in Gender Equality in Society.”** This competition was conducted for the PG students of the Mangalagangothri Campus on 16th February 2022. A total number of 27 students participated in the competition.
