
The Board of Studies (BOS) discussed all matters placed in the agenda including the recommendation of the UGC (D.O. No.F.1.1/2018 (Journal/CARE), December 2019), referred by the University (MU/ACC/CR 67/2020-21/A2, dated 20-05-2021) for incorporation of a course on "Research and Publication Ethics" into Ph. D syllabus and IQAC letter (No. MU/IQAC/2021-22/41, dated 19-08-2021) on the introduction of courses on employability, skill development, gender issues etc. After deliberation the Board passed the following resolution -

Resolution:

1. Place on record the satisfaction about the conduct of examination and question papers of the first and third semester examination held in August 2021.
2. Forward the list of examiners prepared by the BOS to the University with a recommendation to adopt the same for further action.
3. Recommend to the University for adoption and implementation of a course and syllabus on "Research and Publication Ethics", approved by the BOS into the PhD course work and to forward the entire PhD syllabus with programme and course objectives and outcomes to the University.
4. Endorse the introduction and mapping of the PG courses (2020-21 onwards) related to employability, skill development, entrepreneurship, gender issues, sustainable development and professional ethics and forward the same to the University.
