

Instructions to students for the Open Elective Course in Second Semester PG Programme for the year Academic year 2019-20

Mangalore University has revised the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) from the academic year 2016-17. The CBCS not only helps students to take an interdisciplinary approach to the subject which will enable them to obtain useful insights from the new course but also makes the learning process interesting and a rewarding experience. However, students can opt the **UGC PG SWAYAM MOOCs** courses in lieu of Open Elective courses.

Instructions:

- 1. The application shall be downloaded from the University website: www.mangaloreuniversity.ac.in.
- 2. The filled application must be submitted in the given format on or before 19.11.2019 to the Chairperson / Principal of the Department/Colleges.
- 3. The list of the Open Elective Courses and Institutions along with the codes and syllabi of the Open Electives are available in the University website.
- 4. The students are advised to go through the list of open elective courses before choosing their courses and institutions.
- 5. Students must mention <u>TEN</u> choices with five digit code of **the open elective** in the application form in the order of their preference. The five digit code of the open elective course indicates the institution code and course code.
- 6. **75% attendance in the open elective is compulsory**; otherwise, students will have to repeat the course as per the regulation.
- 7. The classes of the open electives are held on Saturdays only.
- 8. The choice of the course shall be within the faculty or across the faculty, but not the one offered by the Programme they are presently studying.
- 9. Allotment of courses is made on the basis of merit and the choices given by the students subject to availability.
- 10. While choosing the course, students must take into consideration both the course and distance to the institution.
- 11. In case a student fails to get the course of her/his choices, then the University will allot the course and institution subject to availability through counseling.
- 12. The choices indicated by the student in the application form are considered as final.
- 13. Students from institutions with multiple programmes will be given preference in their institutions, subject to a limit.
- 14. The students, who furnish false /incorrect information, will not get their choices.
- 15. The student will have to take the University examination of the open elective at the institution where she/he has studied the open elective.

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
