REGULATIONS GOVERNING CREDIT BASED SEMESTER SCHEME FOR BACHELOR OF SCIENCE DEGREE PROGRAMME IN COUNSELING (Framed under section 44(1)(c) of the KSU Act 2000)

PREAMBLE:

In the present context of enormous scientific and technological development, there is lot of demand for courses on Counseling. The graduates of this course can serve as Counselors in Govt. Departments, Old age homes, Children's homes, N.G.O.s , educational institutions, HIV counseling units, hospitals, Alcohol and Drug abuse De-Addiction Counseling Units, Prisons and State Homes etc. This will provide Counseling work force for various Government and Non-Government organizations and awareness programs of the society.

1. <u>TITLE & COMMENCEMENT</u>:

- i) These regulations shall be called "the Regulations governing credit based semester scheme for Bachelor of Science Degree programme in Counseling".
- ii) These regulations shall come into force from the date of assent of the Chancellor.

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

The candidates who have passed the Pre-University examination conducted by the Pre-University Examination Board in the state of Karnataka or any other examination considered as equivalent thereto by Mangalore University are eligible for admission to this programme.

3. DURATION OF PROGRAMME:

The duration of the programme shall extend over six semesters. (Three academic years) of 16 weeks each. Each Semester shall consist of 16 weeks of study. (Excluding the time spent for the conduct of final examination of each semester)

4. <u>SUBJECT OF STUDY</u>:

Subject of study shall comprise the following:

4.1 Group I: Languages:

The candidates shall opt for general and communicative English as compulsory subject and one of the languages listed below.

Kannada, Sanskrit, Hindi, Urdu, Persian, Arabic, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Marathi, French, German, Russian, Konkani and additional English (Additional English is applicable for Anglo Indian and NRI students only).

4.2 Group II: Optional Subjects:

Human Anatomy, General Psychological Process, Human Development, Sociology, Food and Nutrition, Health and Hygiene Education, Foundation of Yogic Science, Community Health, Health Education and Counseling, Psychology, Health Psychology, Physiology, Foundation of Yogic Science II, Statistics, Research Methodology, Industrial Psychology, Pathology, Microbiology, Basic Computer II, Personal and Professional Growth, Educational Psychology, Child Psychology, Social Psychology, Family Work and Family Therapy, Correctional Psychology, National Health Programs and Benefit Schemes, Geriatric Psychology.

4.3 Group III:

Foundation Courses: (i) Constitution of India and (ii) Human Rights, Gender and Environmental Studies shall be as compulsory subjects, alternately, in the first and second semesters.

4.4 Co-and Extra Curricular Activities

A student shall opt for any one of the following activities in the first four semesters offered in the college

- A) N.S.S. / N.C.C / Rovers and Rangers
- B) Sports and Games
- C) Other Co-and Extra-Curricular Activities as prescribed by the university

Evaluation of Co-and Extra Curricular Activities is as per the procedure evolved by the university from time to time
