Dr Y Narayana has been awarded the Dr A K Ganguly Felicitation Prize-2016q The award was recently presented to him by the Director of Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research Dr S A V Sathya Murthy in an award ceremony held at Kalpakkam, Chennai.

The award was instituted by Indian Association for Radiation Protection in 1987 in the memory of Dr A K Ganguly to the scientists below 50 years of age for outstanding work carried out in the field of radiation protection/radiation in the environment.
