The Vice Chancellor Prof. Kishore Kumar C K welcomed the members and directed the IQAC Director Prof. K R Chandrashekar to present the activities of IQAC and to place the agenda for discussion.

Prof. K R Chandrashekar, Director of IQAC, once again welcomed the members and briefed about IQAC activities.

### **Agenda 1: Annual Report**

IQAC was involved in filing the applications for different ranking agencies such as QS India Summit Ranking, US Green metric world ranking, India today ranking etc...

- a) Mangalore University's position in different rankings is as follows
  - QS India Ranking 43 and QS BRICS Ranking-175.
  - US Green Metric World Ranking III Place in the country.
  - India Today Ranking 2017 11<sup>th</sup> Place in the country and 1<sup>st</sup> Place in the state universities of Karnataka.
  - National Institute Ranking Framework 2017 1<sup>st</sup> band (100-150)
- b) The IQAC has successfully submitted AQAR for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 to the NAAC and uploaded in the university website.
- c) The IQAC has developed software for the online collection of student's feedback. The feedback for the year 2017-18 was successfully collected, the analysis was done using the online software.
- d) The IQAC has requested the university to give a wider publicity to this software, so that the software may be shared with other educational institutions.
- e) The Information for AAA report was collected from different Departments/Admin sections, compiled and placed it before the AAA committee which met on 09/10/2018. The committee also visited departments/Admin section and drafted the report in its second meeting held during 28/10/2018.

The Director sought the attention of the members of IQAC to the following pending issues.

- 1. Constitution of the Environmental Audit committee at the earliest.
- 2. Constitution of Sub committees for the preparation of NAAC.
- 3. Constitution of Sub committees of IQAC.

The members urged the university to take immediate action in this regard as these issues may affect the forthcoming Accreditation process.

The Director also stressed the need of sensitising the staff of the university in view of the NAAC process to be initiated and the urgent need of constituting various committees at the earliest.

**Decision:** The annual activity report was appreciated by the Vice Chancellor and members and approved. Regarding the pending issues, the Registrar was informed to take immediate action.
