Report on the NAAC sponsored workshop for the teachers of non accredited colleges of Mangalore University, held at Mangalore University, Mangalagangotri, Karnataka.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Mangalore University organised a two day NAAC sponsored workshop on 'Need for accreditation and sustenance of quality in higher education' on 19 – 20 February, 2015. The chief guest, Prof. S.N. Hegde, former Vice chancellor of University of Mysore, inaugurated the workshop. Speaking on the occasion, he stressed the need for continuous quality initiatives, for the progress of higher educational institutions. President of the function, Prof. K.Byrappa, honourable vice chancellor of Mangalore University, highlighted the importance of NAAC accreditation and sustenance of quality in all spheres of education deliverables. Prof. P.S. Yedapadithaya, Registrar of the University, introduced the dignitaries and Prof. K.K. Vijayalaxmi, Co-ordinator of IQAC and convener of the NAAC workshop gave the spoke on the genesis of the current workshop and gave the details of resource persons and participants. Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbhag explained the various activities of NAAC and advised the participants to initiate the NAAC accreditation process in their respective colleges. Prof. M.Rajashekar, Direcor of college Development Council was present at the occasion.

About 138 teachers from various non-accredited colleges of Mangalore University participated in this workshop. There were eight technical sessions and two open session interactions. In the first session Prof. Raghuveer, Registrar Yenepoya University spoke on the Curricular aspects. He emphasised the need for academic flexibility which enables the takers to learn the life skills and make them competent in the job market. In the next technical session Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbhag, Assistant Adviser NAAC, gave the details of latest guidelines for NAAC accreditation and vividly explained various steps involved in NAAC process and how to prepare the self study report. In the afternoon session, Prof. S.N.Hegde stressed the importance of Research, consultancy and extension activities in the higher education Institutions. A research culture in colleges would ignite the young mind and they develop a "spirit of inquiry" which is important for their future prospects. In the fourth technical session, Sr.Dr. Leonilla Menezes, Principal St.Ann's College of Education Mangalore, shared her experiences of NAAC accreditation process. She advised the participants to make an attempt for the accreditation process, although not successful in the first attempt, success would be achieved subsequently she said. Mr. Dinesh Cowta, Co-Ordinator IQAC, SDM autonomous college Ujire and Dr. Malini Hebbar, IQAC Co-ordinator St. Agnes college joined the interactive session on invitation. They briefly explained their experiences of NAAC accreditation process in their colleges. In the interactive session, all the resource persons of first day sessions participated and clarified the doubts raised by teachers on various aspects of accreditation process and quality improvement.

On the second day, 20th February session started with a lecture by Dr. B.S. Madhukar, Director, IQAC, University of Mumbai who spoke on quality assurance. In his speech, he explained the various facets of quality assurance and how they are analysed before, during and after the assessment. He also, mentioned about the importance of Internal Quality

Assurance cell in adding value to the life of students. In his second lecture in the afternoon session, he highlighted the importance of able governance and leadership at various levels of Institutional administration. In the morning session, Prof. P. Ventataramaiah, former vice chancellor of Kuvempu University, focussed on the teaching -learning process, stressed the importance of well informed teaching fraternity and how the performance evaluation of teachers is important in maintaining quality in higher education. Dr. M.K. Bhandi, Librarian Mangalore University, briefed on how the institutions can improve the library facility and its usage. Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbhag, in her second lecture explained about the 'best practices' and how it can be projected while preparing the SSR and she also clarified the doubts raised by the participants regarding this aspect. Dr. Rameela shekar, Dean & IQAC Co- ordinator of School of social work, Roshni Nilaya on of the autonomous colleges joined the interactive session proceedings on invitation, and expressed her views about the internal quality assurance cell and the importance of NAAC accreditation. In the interactive session, the resource persons clarified the specific doubts raised by the participants of the workshop. This session was followed by valedictory function which was presided over by Prof. K. Byrappa honourable vice chancellor and Prof. P. Venkataramaiah and Dr. Sujatha Shanbhag were the chief guests. Prof. Byrappa gave his presidential remarks on the workshop and chief guests gave some tips on NAAC processes. The workshop ended with vote of thanks extended to all by Prof. K.K. Vijayalaxmi, Co ordinator IQAC and convener of the workshop.

Valedictory function of the workshop will be held on 20th Feb 2015 at 4.30 p.m. Prof. P. Venkataramiah, Former Vice Chancellor of Kuvempu University and Dr. Sujatha P. Shanbhag, Assistant Advisor, NAAC, Bangaluru are the chief guests. Prof. K. Byrappa, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Mangalore University will preside over the function.

About 125 Principals/Senior faculty members from non-accredited colleges affiliated to Mangalore University will participate in this programme. The NAAC is an autonomous body established by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India to assess and accredit institutions of higher education in the country. Prof. K. K. Vijayalaxmi, Co-ordinator, IQAC is the convener of workshop. Prof. M. Rajashekhar, Director, College Development Council and Prof. P.S. Yadapadithaya, Registrar, Mangalore University will be present in the functions.
