

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. What is the last date for admissions
Normally admissions are made during the month of July to August.
2. What is the fee for application, Admission & Exam
Fee for application is Rs. 300/- in person By post Rs. 340/-
Annual Fee: for B.A Rs. 3,000; for B.Com Rs. 3,300; for B.B.A Rs. 3,600/- for All P.G courses Rs. 6,900/- at the time of admission.
3. What about Contact Classes.
Contact classes will be conducted during January to April on Sundays only. Normally in each subject 2 rounds of classes will be conducted.
4. Submission of Assignment Papers.
At the time of admission, information regarding topics for assignments and last date for submission will be given.
5. Payment of Exam fees.
Usually notification regarding payment of examination fee will be notified in the website during the month of March and exams will be held during the month of June/July.
6. How to apply for Post matric Scholarship.
Candidates belonging to SC/ST category can apply for Post matric Scholarship through online notified by the Social Welfare office.
7. Which are the Exam Centres?
Students of Distance Education can select Exam. Centres at Mangalore, Udupi, Puttur & Madikeri at the time of Filling up examination applications.
8. Date of Enrolment for 2nd/3rd year courses.
Students can enrol for the 2nd or 3rd year respectively during the month of July/August.
9. Announcement of Results.
Students can check their results at the University Website during August/September. Marks cards will be despatched to the students by Regd. Post.
10. Payment of fees regarding Revaluation/Retotalling/Correction of marks cards, Improvement/Rejection of Results.
Information regarding Revaluation/Retotalling /Correction of marks cards, Improvement/Rejection of Results etc. will be given at the time of despatch of marks card.
