

Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2019-20

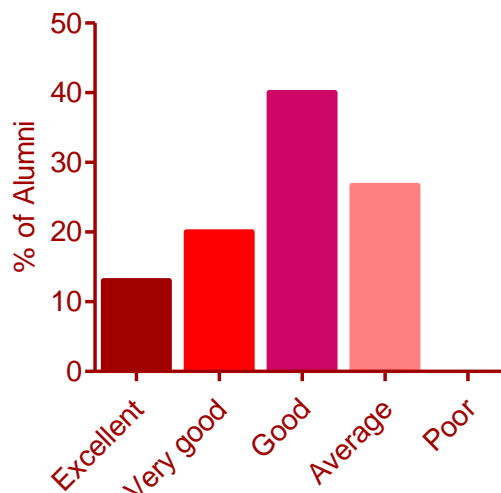
Premise

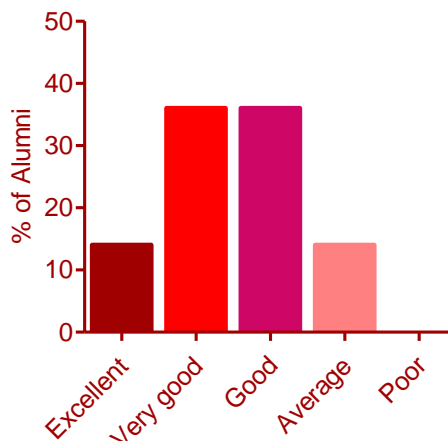
Curriculum-related

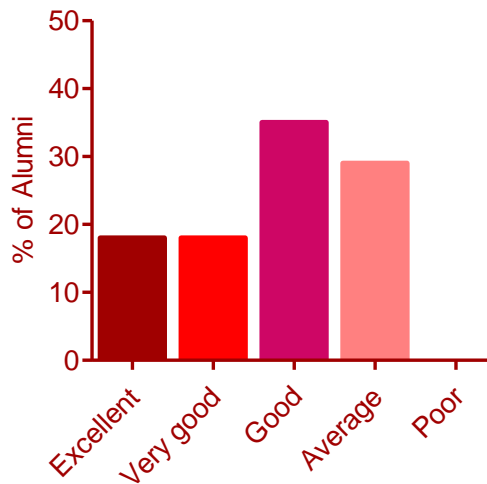
Rating of Courses learnt as suiting the requirements of the Industry



Rating of learning experience in terms of relevance to real life application

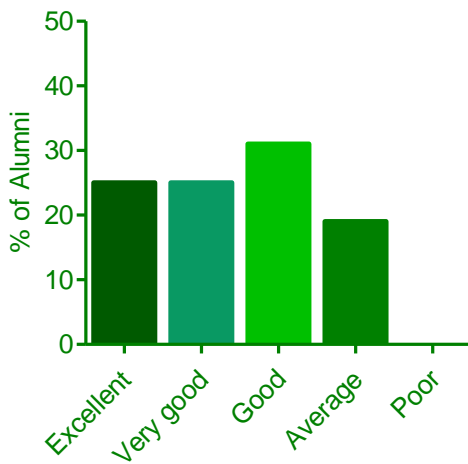


Rating of courses learnt in relation to current job

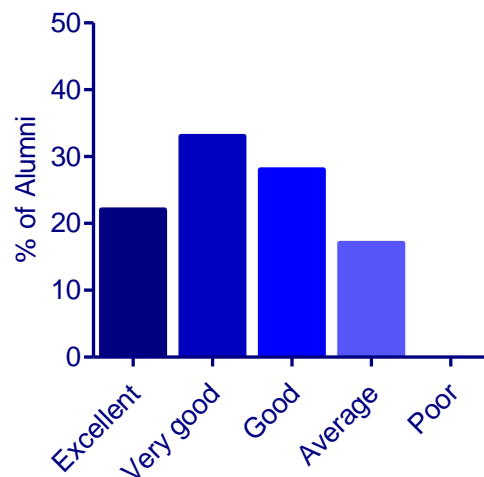

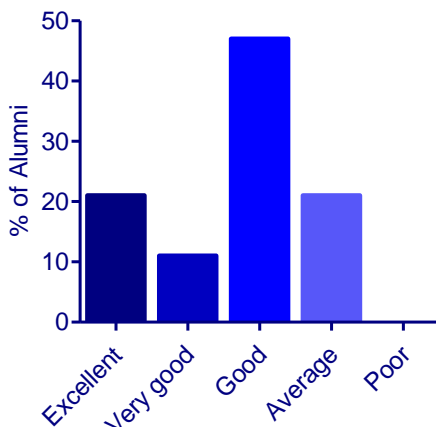
Industry-oriented projects



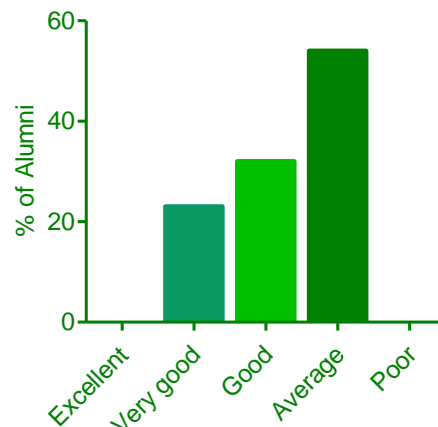
Seminars and workshop



Guest lectures



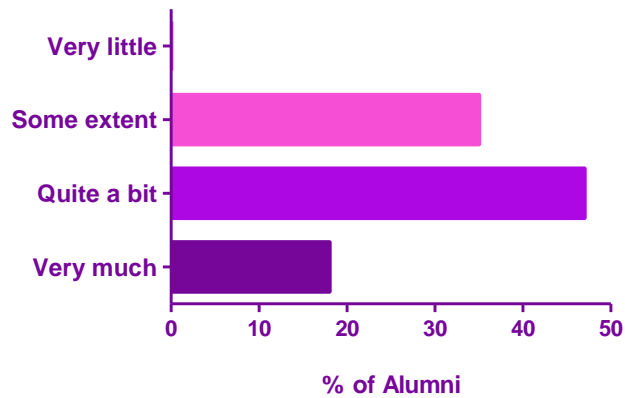
Special training classes for bridging the Industry/academia gap



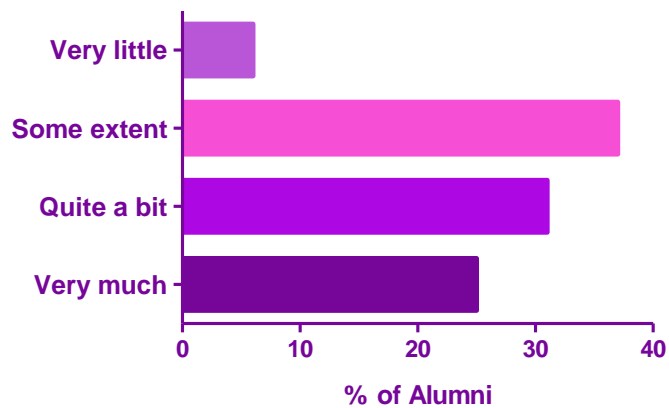
Fulfilment of Programme Educational Objectives
