Prof. Kishori Nayak, Director, IQAC and Chairperson of the Committee welcomed all the members gathered in the meeting. She briefed the meeting about the structure of the electives under Group II and said that open electives are to be offered only in the fourth semester Choice Based Credit System as mentioned in page 2 of the Regulations.

After intensive discussion in the meeting about issues related to the adoption of Open elective courses, the following decisions were taken;

1. The open elective course chosen by a student in the fourth semester must be unrelated to the discipline / domain which he / she has been studying in the main programme.

2. The colleges offering multiple programmes can make provision within their colleges for making Cross-disciplinary options available to their students.

- 3. There are about 31 colleges which offer only one programme. Of these, 5 are offering only B.Sc. programmes and 26 are Commerce colleges. It is suggested that these single faculty Colleges may offer any one of the following courses mentioned below as the Open elective:
  - Physical Education
  - Yogic Science
  - Karnataka Music or Bharathanatvam

- The courses offered as open electives by the Boards of Studies in Optional Kannada/ Sanskrit/ Hindi/English: These could be taught by the qualified faculty teaching the said languages.
- 4. If the single faculty colleges are not able to manage open elective options as per the above suggestions, they may negotiate with any neighbouring colleges offering other programs and approach the University with suggestions for mutual co-operation between the two colleges which can then be approved as a cluster.

At the end of the meeting the Chairperson of the committee thanked all the members for their valuable input and feedback.
