AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ADMISSION TO THE POST-GRADUATE DEGREE/ DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES OF MANGALORE UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENTS

(Framed under Section 44(1)(c) of K.S.U. Act 2000)

Preamble:

The Government of Karnataka/ UGC has instructed to reserve the seats for certain categories as detailed below:-

Government of Karnataka Gazette Notification Order No. - 3% of the available seats for Physically handicapped students ED 10 STB 97, dated 2.01.2001

(ii) Government of Karnataka Letter No. ED 254 UKV 2010, dated 13.12.2013

- 1% of the available seats for the third Gender (as per Supreme Court Order dated 15th April 2014) Students

(iii) Government of Karnataka Circular No.: ED 269 UNE 2014, dated 13.05.2014

- 8% of the available seats for the students of Hyderabad -Karnataka Region

(iv) UGC letter No. F 1-13/2010 (CPP-II), dated 23.03.2015

- One seat for wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

Government of Karnataka Order No.: ED 150 UNE 2015, - 15% Extra seats for other University Candidates. dated 21.05.2015

Further, the Academic Council at its meeting held on 16.09.2008 has decided to reserve seats for wards of Mangalore University employees and at the meeting held on 13.01.2015 has decided to reserve one seat each for the students involved in NCC, NSS, Sports, Scouts (Rovers and Rangers) and Cultural activities.

All the above reservations are to be incorporated in the Regulations governing the admission to the Post-graduate Degree/ Diploma Programmes of Mangalore University Departments. Hence, this amendment.

- ii) Seats shall be allotted in favour of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes and other backward classes in accordance with the general or special directions of the State Government issued in this regard from time to time.
- c) Seats shall be reserved for the candidates mentioned below outside the intake fixed under category I, in each programme;
 - i) Not more than five seats in each programme for foreign students allotted at the discretion of the Vice-Chancellor in consultation with the respective selection committee.
 - ii) One seat for candidates recommended by the State/ Central Government.
 - iii) One seat for children of the defence personnel (Army, Navy and Air Force). However, if no children of the defence personnel are available for admission, the seats shall then be allotted to the children of ex-servicemen. If no candidates in the above two categories are available, such seats may be allotted to candidates who are dependents of the defence personnel (dependents means wife, brothers and unmarried sisters of the servicemen).
 - iv) One seat for Physically handicapped. The candidate shall be selected by the Committee constituted by the University.

- iii) 8% of the total intake shall be reserved for the students of Hyderabad-Karnataka region.
- c) Seats shall be reserved for the candidates mentioned below outside the intake fixed under category I, in each programme;
 - i) Five seats in each programme shall be allotted for foreign students. However, the Vice Chancellor in consultation with the respective selection committee can increase the number of seats if foreign students are available.
