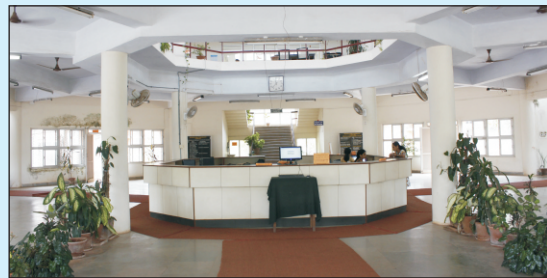

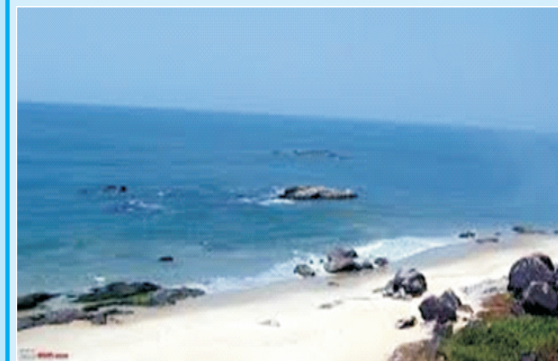

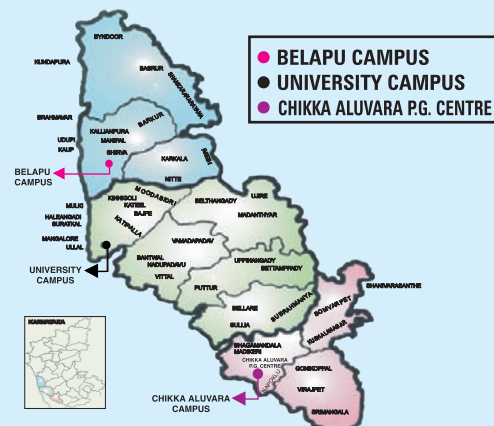

Unique literary heritage – Dr Kota Shivarama Karanth, Jnanpeeth Awardee, wrote from here

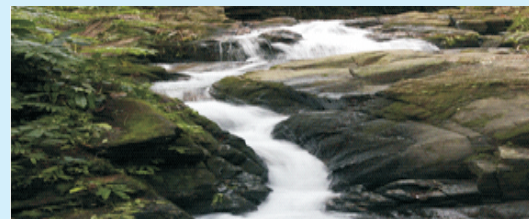
Unique cultural heritage – the air resounds with the ritual theatre of Yakshagana and the Spirit worship of Bhootakola
