ELIGIBILITY:

Candidates for admission to the Ph.D programme shall have a master's degree or a
professional degree declared equivalent to the master's degee by the corresponding
statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B'
in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system
is followed).

The foreign students, including those applying through their Govt. agencies/ embassies should contact the respective department in which they intend to register for the ph.D Programme, to get clearance from the Department Council concerned through the Director, International Student Centre of the University.

- 2. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation in grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/CAT-I (non-creamy layer)/ differently- abled and other categories of candidates or for those who had obtained their master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991 as per UGC norms. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying examination marks without including any gracing.
- 3. Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. Programme with course work, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) shall be eligible to register for Ph.D programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ CAT-I (non-creamy layer)/ differently- abled and other categories of candidates as per UGC norms.
- 4. Candidates possessing a degree considered equivalent to M. Phil. Degree with course work of an India/Foreign educational institution shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D programme (please see clause 1)
