The cost of this programme is estimated at Rs.1,13,000 crore. Prime Minister himself would be monitoring this programme.

Digital India Programme seeks to be transformative in totality with its vision centering around three key areas:

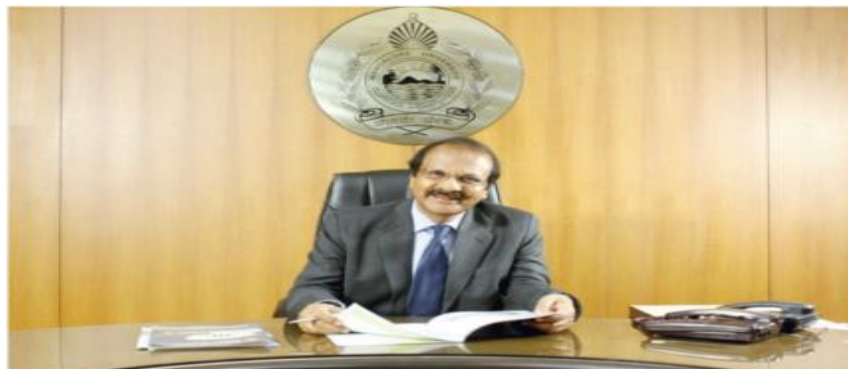

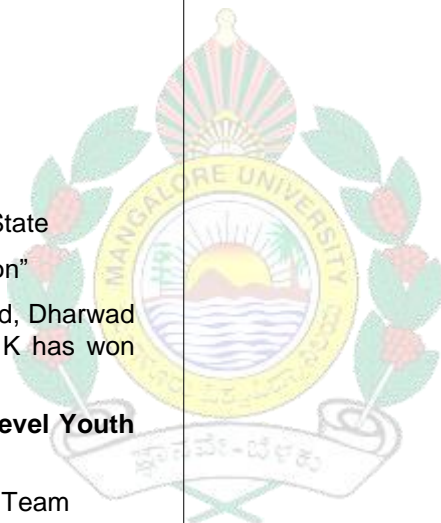
