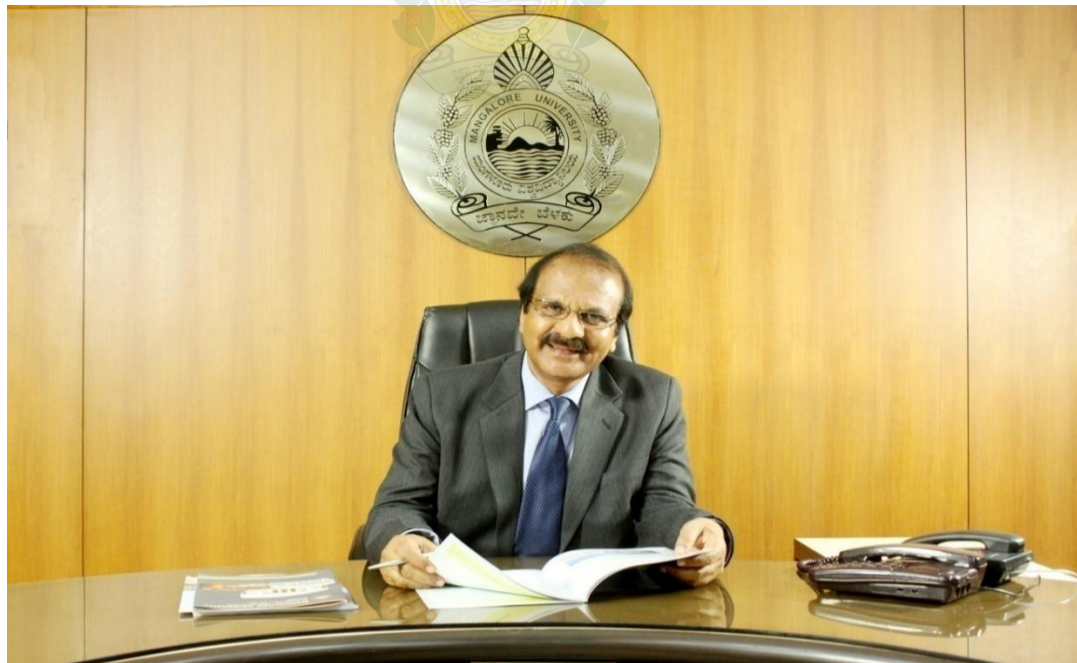

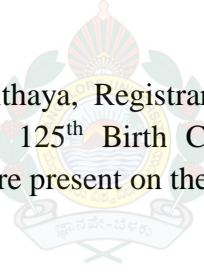
**125<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Jawaharlal Nehru celebrated**

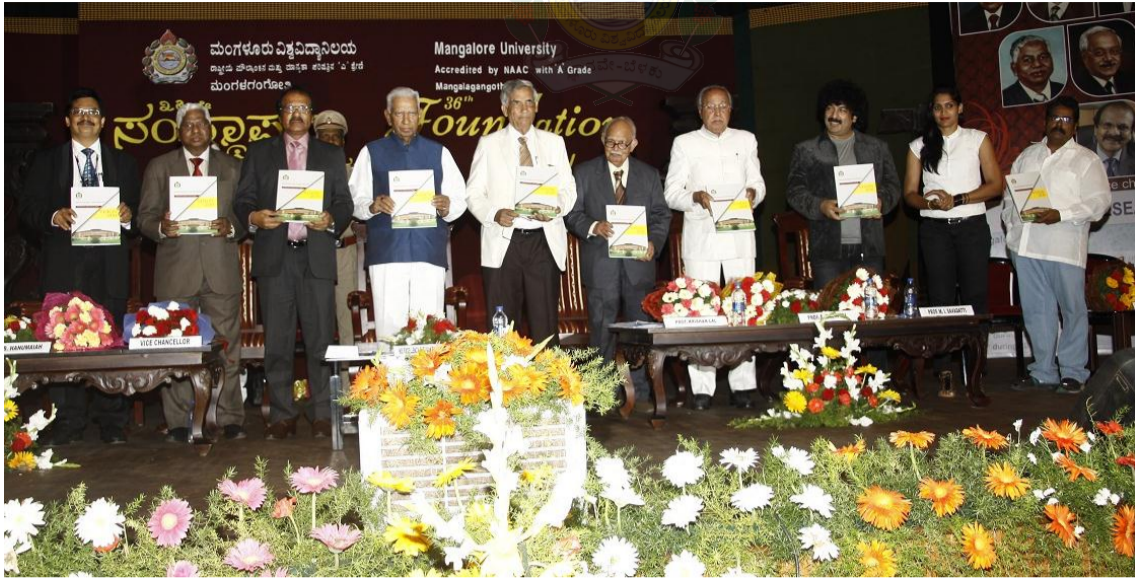
