Details of the Discussion

- 1) Panel of examiners for M.Sc. Geoinformatics was prepared and sent to the Registrar (Evaluation), Mangalore University, Mangalagangothri.
- 2) The previous year's M.Sc. question papers and the M.Sc. results were assessed and were found satisfactory.
- 3) PG BOS amended the syllabi for the choice based credit system of two years (four semesters) M.Sc. in Geoinformatics. The changes are: II semester paper GIS 454: (Applied Geomorphology) and GIS 455: Geo Environmental Science have been

combined and the new paper title would be GIS 454: Applied Geomorphology and Geo Environmental Science. In Place of Paper GIS 455 New Practical Paper GIP 455: Petrology and Geomorphology has been added.

The Syllabus for GIS 454: Applied Geomorphology and Geo Environmental Science have been prepared and accepted. The same may be placed in Faculty of Science for approval.
