Pattern for Entrance Test:

- The Entrance Test shall consist of a paper for 70 marks of 120 minutes duration and an interview for 30 marks.
 - The Question Paper shall be based on the syllabus of the PG course of MCJ Programme and Research Methodology (RM) with a weightage of 70:30. It shall contain objective type and descriptive short answer type questions in the ratio of 50:50.

The MA syllabus is available on the University website and the common themes of Research Methodology will be included for the Entrance Test.

The Question paper shall have four sections:

- a) Section A consists of 35 multiple Choice (Objective type) questions for one mark each (RM = 10 + PG Syllabus = 25).
- b) Section B consists of short note questions on Research Methodology: (2 out of $3:2 \times 5 = 10$)
- c) Section C consists of short note questions on the PG Syllabus: (2 out of 3: 2 x 5 = 10)
