AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING CREDIT BASED SEMESTER SCHEME FOR BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES IN THE FACULTIES OF ARTS, SCIENCE AND COMMERCE

(Framed under Section 44 (1) (c) of the KSU Act 2000)

Preamble:

The University Grants Commission vide letter F.No.1-11/2007 (CPP-II), dated 16.08.2007 has informed that M.H.R.D. has constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Shri J.M.Lyngdoh to examine and recommend certain aspects about student body and student union election conducted in Universities, Colleges and other institutions of higher education across India. This Committee has submitted its report and the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 22nd September 2006 has directed that the recommendations of the Committee are to be implemented and shall be followed in all Colleges/Universities.

Based on this report, the Syndicate of Mangalore University while revising the fee for condonation of shortage of attendance during the meeting held on 3.12.2014 has decided not to condone the shortage of attendance and to delete the provision of condonation of shortage of attendance from the Regulations governing Bachelor degree programmes.

Further, Government of Karnataka vide letters No.ED 01 UDS 2015 dated 14.06.2016 and ED 9 UDS 2016 dtd.24.10.2016 has directed the University to include 50% attendance criteria for Co- curricular and extra-curricular activities to promote the same.

Hence, this amendment.
