MANGALORE UNIVERSITY PROFILE

Mangalore University is known for its rich heritage of Academic pursuits, Cultural and sports vibrancy and is one of the most sought after universities in India.

Mangalore University established in 1980, has its adminstrative and main campus of Post-Graduate Studies in Mangalagangotri. It is situtated in an area of about 353 acres flanked by the Indian Ocean on one side and Western Ghats on the other. Mangalore University has grown impressively since its inception with 204 affiliated colleges, two constituent colleges (at Mangalore and Madikeri) and five autonomous colleges.

Mangalore University, since its inception in 1980, has continued its sports legacy throughout its existence. Beginning with Mrs. Vandana Rao who won three gold medals in All India Inter University competitions and went on to represent India In Olympics in 1984, to Mr. Dharun Ayyasamy representing India in the Olympics and setting a national record in 400 mts. hurdles, Mangalore University has produced a plethora of sports stars.



The tournament will be jointly organised by Government First Grade College, Virajpet which is an affiliated college of Mangalore University established in 2007. The vision of the institution is to empower students' socio-economically for a healthy society through knowledge based quality education. Started with humble beginnings with 120 students, it now boasts of a student strength of 600 students undergoing programmes like BA, BCom, BBA and BSc.

It is situated in a lovely campus surrounded by lush green forest in the heartland of the town of Virajpet.

The tournament will be conducted in **DYES Hockey Stadium, Ponnampet** from **December 27 to 31, 2021.** Ponnampet is situated about 175 Kms from Mangalore and 90 kms. from Mysore. Kodagu is the cradle of hockey in Karnataka and had produced many international hockey stars such as S V Sunil, Arjun Halappa, A B Subbaiah etc.





Mangalore University is home to many Olympians such as Vandana Rao, Satish Rai, Dharun A, M R Poovamma, Hockey Internationals such as Ponnamma M N and Leelavathi M and former Kabaddi national team captain Mamatha Poojary.

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

Reaching the venue involves both train and bus travel. It can be approached in 3 ways:



Teams alight 1. can at Mysore railway station and move to the KSRTC bus terminal where they can board the bus to Gonikoppal distance is 90 km. Please note that not all buses going Madikeri towards pass through Gonikoppal.

2. Teams travelling via Mangalore can alight at Mangalore Cent. railway St., catch autos to KSRTC bus stand and board the bus to Gonikoppal via Madikeri. They can even board the Mysore bound busses plying through Gonikoppal - distance is 175 km.

3. Teams arriving by train via the Kerala route can alight at Kannur or Thalassery (whichever station is convenient) and travel by bus to Gonikoppal. - distance 90 km.

There will be a reception counter at the Gonikoppal bus stand from Dec. 25, 2021. The teams are requested to inform of their ETA upon boarding the bus to Gonikoppal from either of the 3 locations.


* Please note that there are no facilities for train reservation at the venue. Therefore ensure the booking of return journey in advance to avoid inconvenience.



ACCOMODATION

The teams will be provided with unfurnished Rooms/Halls for their stay during the days of competitions. They have to pay a caution deposit of **Rs. 2000/-** which is refundable. We have very limited lodging facilities; hence the teams are requested to arrive at the venue of the tournament a day before the competition date and to leave the venue within 24 hours of completion of their competition.

NOTE: Matches 1 to 14 will be played on 27.12.2021. The league matches will be played on 30-12-2021 evening and 31-12-2021.

The organising committee reserves the right to alter the schedule of the matches.

RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

- 1. The Tournament shall be conducted as per the Rules of the International Hockey Federation except in circumstances such as duration and tie breaker as decided by the Tournament Committee.
- 2. Matches shall be conducted in the format of 4 quarters of 15 minutes each and tie breaker in the elimination round shall be conducted by shootout.
- 3. All matches shall be played on the artificial turf field. Balls shall be provided by the Organisers.
- 4. Each team shall pay the officiating fee of Rs. 1500 per match.
- 5. The teams shall report at least 30 mintues before the match.
- 6. The teams shall provide the following documents for each of their players while registering:
 - (a) Eligibiity form in quadruplicate duly signed by the competent authority.
 - (b) Attested copy of SSLC or any document as proof of date of birth
 - (b) Attested copy of PUC or equivalent / Degree certificates (in case of PG students).
 - (c) Certificate of double vaccination or RTP-PCR certificate not earlier than 72 hours from date of reporting is mandatory for both the players and accompanying officials.
 - (d) Copy of AADHAAR certificate
 - (e) Medical Fitness Certificate
- 7. All teams should participate with their university flag during the inaugural function.
- 8. The Organisers shall reserve the right to make changes in the schedule as they deem necessary.



INSTRUCTIONS

PLACES OF INTEREST

1. There will be a Managers Meeting on **December 26, 2021** the venue and time of which will be informed later.

2. The weather around this time of the year is very cold dropping below 10°C, so the participants are advised to bring enough warm clothing.

3. The participants are requested to bring blankets, though basic facilities will be provided freely or on rent.
