Applications in the prescribed form are invited from qualified candidates of Indian Nationality for the following Teaching Posts in Local Cadre (Hyderabad- Karnataka) in Mangalore University. The applications in TEN sets together with necessary documents should be sent in the envelope, super scribed on top of the cover "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF....." addressed to THE REGISTRAR, MANGALORE UNIVERSITY, MANGALAGANGOTHRI-574199, D.K., KARNATAKA on or before **10.07.2017**, at 5.00 PM by RPAD. Candidates may also submit their applications in person and obtain acknowledgement.

Applications in the prescribed format were invited to fill up the teaching posts in the cadre of Professors/Associate Professors/Assistant Professors under various disciplines vide notification cited at ref(4) and revised notification was issued to the same vide ref(5) restricting the eligibility to the candidates of Karnataka only. In the notification dated 17.03.2016 and 01.06.2016, though the number of teaching posts in the cadre of Professors and Assistant Professors was indicated, the breakup of posts into Local and Residual Parent Cadres was not indicated in terms of Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation for appointment for Hyderabad Karnataka candidates) order 2013. Hence action has been taken for cadre bifurcation and with due approval from the Government, Notification had been issued vide notification cited under reference (7) above. Hence the Notifications dated 17.03.2016 and 01.06.2016 stand cancelled. **The candidates who have applied in response to the said notifications need to apply again with the prescribed fees.**

Consequent to the issue of the cadre bifurcation notification, such of the staff who qualified for being classified as local persons were identified, their option was sought and accordingly they have been allotted to the respective cadres based on their option. Thus the clear vacancy available in the local (Hyderabad Karnataka) Cadre is as hereunder:

NOTE :

- (1) The posts in the local cadre can be filled up only by such of applicants who qualify for being classified as local persons in terms of para 6 of the Karnataka Public Employment (Reservation for appointment for Hyderabad-Karnataka candidates) Order 2013. Such of those who qualify for being classified as local persons shall produce the eligibility certificate issued by the competent authority in terms of the above order.
- (2) Candidates belonging to Karnataka State only are eligible to apply for the reserved posts.
- (3) The classification of above posts to various categories may vary.
- (4) If women candidates are not available for the posts reserved for them, the applications of men candidates will be considered. Therefore men also may apply for the posts reserved for women.

QUALIFICATIONS :

The minimum qualifications prescribed for the above posts are as per the U.G.C. norms and the Statute. Knowledge of Kannada is desirable.

PROFESSOR :

- (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers in indexed/ISBN/ISSN numbered journals and/or ISBN/ISSN numbered books and the University developed ISBN/ISSN numbered list of journals/books hosted in the website of the University.
- (ii) A minimum of 10 years of teaching experience in University/College, and/or experience in research at the University/National Level Institutions/Industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) developed by the UGC in its Regulations.

OR

An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/ allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/ relevant disciplines.
- (ii) 55% of the marks, or equivalent grade wherever grading system is followed at the Master's degree level.
- (iii) A minimum of 08 years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University/Constituent College or Accredited Research Institution/ industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers in indexed/ISBN/ISSN - numbered books/ journals and University developed-ISBN/ISSN list of journals hosted in the website of the University.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) developed by the UGC in its Regulations.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR:

- (i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% of the marks or equivalent grade where grading system is practiced at the Master's degree level, in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- (iii) Holders of Ph.D. degree as on the date of Notification of the UGC Regulations, along with those candidates who are awarded a Ph.D. degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the UGC Regulations, 2009 (Minimum Standards and Procedures for award of M.Phil./Ph.D.) and subsequent amendments made by the UGC, so adopted by the University, shall be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.
- (iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters' Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted subject to the conditions stipulated above.

NOTE:

1. A relaxation of 5% is provided, i.e. a minimum requirement of marks, from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST/Differently Abled categories.
2. A relaxation of 5% is provided, i.e. a minimum requirement of marks, from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level, to the Ph.D. degree holders who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991.

AGE LIMIT: Maximum - 61 years**APPLICATION & PROCESSING FEE:**

For all posts, the prescribed fee is Rs.1000/- (in case of SC/ST, Rs.500/-)

The Application fees should be paid through Challan or by means of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of The Finance Officer, Mangalore University payable at Mangalagangothri and submitted along with the filled application.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Ex-servicemen or children of defence personnel killed or disabled in action and Physically Handicapped Persons are exempted from payment of application fee(Govt. Notification No DPAR 142 SRR 2006 dtd: 05.11.2007) provided they furnish appropriate certificate issued by the Competent Authority along with the filled-in- applications.
2. Separate applications with separate fee are required to be submitted for separate posts.
3. The filled-in-application which does not accompany with the prescribed fee is liable for rejection
4. Those who are in service should send their applications along with duly attested service certificate through **proper channel** on or before the last date fixed.
5. **Candidates belonging to Karnataka State only are eligible to apply for the reserved posts.**
6. The copies of the publications and true copies of Testimonials/Certificates/Statement of marks/ Services Certificate/Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority should be enclosed to all the Ten sets, which will not be returned.
7. The applicant shall carefully fill in the prescribed application form. The copies of documents in support of claim made must be enclosed to the application. If copies of documents are not sent with the application, claims made will be rejected. Documents not enclosed to the application but produced at the time of interview will also be rejected.
8. Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/ Rural/ Kannada Medium /Physically handicapped/Hyderabad-Karnataka, shall be required to attach the certificate issued by the competent and authorized authority.[In case of OBC, latest certificate is to be enclosed]
9. The applications received after the last date, the applications which are incomplete and those not in the prescribed format and less than Tensets are liable to be rejected and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
10. The candidate will be held responsible for furnishing any false information in the application form and liable to action deemed fit including rejection of application.
11. Candidates selected should be prepared to work anywhere in Mangalore University jurisdiction including the Post Graduate Centres/ Constituent Colleges.
12. The selected candidates are governed by the Rules and Regulations of the University.
13. The Candidates selected will be appointed on probation for a period of two years; probationary period may be extended if the Authorities of the University so desire.
14. The selected candidates shall execute a service agreement with the University and they shall be governed by the new pension scheme as per Govt. Order No. FD(Spl)04 PET 2005, Bangalore, dated 31.03.2006 and further any Government orders issued in this behalf.
15. The application fee shall not be refundable under any circumstances.
16. Canvassing directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidates.
17. Candidates who have studied under Trimester System and other, the 10 points grading system are required to produce the equivalent percentage certificate

obtained from the respective University, if equivalence details are not mentioned in the mark sheets.

18. For all the clarifications in assessment of API scores or any parameter for teaching posts and for any interpretational operation purpose, the UGC Regulations 2010 and the University Statutes shall be followed/referred to (which are available in our University website).
19. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill the posts.
