Entrance Test	: 13.09.2021 – Monday from 10.00a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
Interview*	: 13.09.2021 – Monday 2.00 p.m. onwards
Venue	: Department of Computer Science, Mangalagangothri Campus

- Entrance test fee Rs.1000/- (Rs. 500/- for SC/ST and Category I candidates) in the form of Demand Draft (DD) in favour of the Finance Officer, Mangalore University, Mangalagangothri, has to be submitted before appearing for the entrance test.
- Marks Cards of the qualifying examination and category certificate (if claimed) have to be produced in original before appearing for the entrance test.
- If the candidate is employed and has not submitted the application through proper channel, he / she is required to produce **No Objection Certificate** from the employer, at the time of entrance test, without which the application will be rejected.
- All candidates (except those who have qualified UGC/CSIR (JRF)/NET/SLET/GATE and Teacher Fellow/ M.Phil Degree holder) will have to write Entrance Test. All the candidates including those who have qualified UGC/CSIR(JRF)/NET/SLET/GATE and Teacher Fellow/M.Phil Degree holder have to appear for the interview. Senior Scientists (Scientist D and above) are exempted from written test and interview. If you seek exemption kindly produce appropriate documents.
- The Entrance Test shall consist of a paper for 70 marks of 120 minutes duration and an interview for 30 marks. The question paper for the entrance test is based on 30% from Research Methodology (Syllabus in the website) and 70% from M.Sc Computer Science Syllabus. The question paper for the written test will contain objective type and short answer type questions in ratio of 50:50 under each category (Research Methodology and PG Syllabus).
