**INTIMATION LETTER FOR Ph.D ENTRANCE TEST- 2023 in MCJ**

Dear Applicant,

This is to inform you that the **Entrance Test and Interviews** for admission to Ph.D Programme in MCJ is scheduled on **Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at 10.00 am**. Those who have cleared NET / SLET may appear only for the interview which will also commence at 11.00 am in the MCJ Department.

Successful candidates will be informed separately later.

**Please note the following:**

Test and Interview Date	:	Saturday, 18 <sup>th</sup> March 2023
Duration of Test	:	10.00 am to 12.00 pm. (2 hours)
Venue	:	Dept. of MCJ II Floor, Humanities Block, Adjacent to University Library

**Pattern for Entrance Test:**

- The Entrance Test shall consist of a paper for 70 marks of 120 minutes (2 hours) duration and an interview for 30 marks.
- The Question Paper shall be based on the syllabus of the PG course of MCJ Programme and Research Methodology (RM) with a weightage of 70:30. It shall contain objective type and descriptive short answer type questions in the ratio of 50:50.

**The PG Course syllabus is available in the University website and the common themes of Research Methodology will be included for the Entrance Test.**


The Question paper shall have four sections:

- a) Section A consists of 35 multiple Choice (Objective type) questions for one mark each (RM 10 + PG Syllabus 25= 35).
- b) Section B consists of short note questions on Research Methodology:  
(2 out of 3: 2 x 5 = 10)
- c) Section C consists of short note questions on the PG Syllabus:  
(2 out of 3: 2 x 5 = 10)
- d) A research proposal Question for 15 marks.

Please Note:

- Candidates who have cleared JRF/NET/SLET/KSET are **not** required to take the Entrance Test, but they must appear for the Interview.
- Those who have **not submitted the copies of all the relevant marks cards** and the other relevant credentials should bring the same along with the **Original certificates** for the Interview.
- **Applicants who have not paid the Entrance Test fee of Rs.1000/- (Rs.500/- for SC/ST/Cat-I) shall bring a DD / Paid challan along with them.**
- Candidates will not be allowed to write the test if they do not fulfill the above requirements.
