UNIT - I

Social Marketing: Approaches of Campaign against Drugs Abuse. Steps involved in developing Information, Education and Communication (IEC) materials. Social Media based campaign against substance use.

UNIT - II

Social Work Interventions: Curative Interventions: Assessment and Diagnosis, Treatment Plan, Motivational interventions, Relapse Prevention Intervention, Cognitive Behavioural interventions, Family Interventions, Group Interventions, Follow ups and collateral contacts.

UNIT - III

School Based Interventions: Preventive Interventions: Role of School counsellors, Components of School Based Awareness Programmes to prevent Drug Abuse. Characteristics of vulnerable children and individualised care for such children.

UNIT - IV

College Based Interventions: Role of College counsellors, College/University based drug abuse prevention programmes, role of peer counsellors, development of social safety net for young adults. Role of NSS and NCC volunteers in prevention of substance abuse in higher educational institutions.

UNIT - V

Community based and Workplace Interventions: Role of key stakeholders in drug abuse prevention. Strategies to identify the vulnerable communities and affected members of community. Rural and Urban Outreach Programmes, Benefits of workplace based interventions for treating addiction disorders. Models of Workplace based drug abuse prevention.
