The Clause No.4.1.15 & 4.2.25(pertaining to Eligibility of the Programmes) of the Regulations governing Choice Based Credit System for the two years (four semesters) Post Graduate degree Programmes under Arts, Science and Technology, Commerce and Education Discipline (CBCS-PG) has been amended and implemented in the academic year 2022-23. The Government vide its letter referred to above has communicated the assent of the Honorable Chancellor to this amendment. Hence, the implementation of this amendment to the Regulations for the academic year 2022-23 is hereby confirmed and shall continue from the academic year 2022-23 and onwards.

Amendments to the Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for the two years (Four Semesters) Post Graduate Degree Programmes in the Faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce and Education.

(Amendments to Eligibility criteria, for admission to Masters in Kodava and Medical Physics)
(Framed under Section 44 (1) (c) of the K.S.U Act 2000)

Preamble:

The term Kodava is used to refer to the language and to the community of Kodava people. Kodava thakk is the mother tongue of not only Kodava Community and the 20 communities who are the inhabitants of Kodagu. Kodava language is not only a mean of communication but also a repository of cultural values and traditions of a people. It is spoken by the native communities of the district of Kodagu in the state of Karnataka. Language experts consider it is an independent Dravidian language and it is to be one of the oldest spoken languages in South India. It is a language that is rich in traditional folk literature folk songs, folk tales, folk plays, proverbs riddles and sayings. M.A. programme in Kodava will meet the needs of Kodava language proponents.

The Board of Studies in Medical Physics decided to recommend a minor change in the existing eligibility criteria for admission to the M.Sc. Medical Physics programme, considering the students larger interest and attracting meritorious students.

Hence, the Regulations governing the Choice Based Credit System for the two years (four semesters) Postgraduate degree programmes have been amended duly revising the clause No. 4(4.1& 4.2). Other clauses are unaltered and are also applicable for the above said programmes.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:</p> <p>4.1 FACULTY OF ARTS:</p> <p>4.1.15 M.A. in Kodava: Candidates who have passed the three years degree examination (any degree) of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Kannada as major/optional subject are eligible for the programme provided they have secured a minimum of 45% (40% for SC/ST/Category-I) marks in Kannada. Candidates who have not studied kannada at degree level and studied P.C. Diploma in Kodava are also eligible for the programme.</p>	<p>4. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:</p> <p>4.1 FACULTY OF ARTS:</p> <p>4.1.15 MA in Kodava: Candidates who have passed any degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto and are fluent in written and spoken Kodava are eligible for the programme.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Candidates who have completed Post Graduate Diploma in Kodava are also eligible for the programme.</p>
<p>4.2.25 M.Sc. in Medical Physics: Candidates who have passed the three-year B.Sc. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Physics as major / optional/ special subject are eligible for the programme provided they have studied Mathematics as major / optional / special / minor / subsidiary subject for at least two years and secured a minimum of 65% (60% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in Physics.</p>	<p>4.2.25 M.Sc. in Medical Physics: Candidates who have passed the three-year B.Sc. degree examination of Mangalore University or any other University considered as equivalent thereto with Physics as major / optional/ special subject are eligible for the programme provided they have studied Mathematics as major / optional / special / minor / subsidiary subject for at least ONE year and secured a minimum of 65% (60% for SC/ST/Category-I candidates) marks in Physics.</p>
