

VENUE AND DATE





HOW TO REACH THE **VENUE**

Reaching the venue involves both train and bus travel. It can be approached in 2 ways:





Teams arriving from North via Konkan Railway can alight at Udupi railway station which is 4 kms from the venue. Transport arrangements to the venue will be made by the organisers. Alternatively teams can come from the railway station to the venue by auto.

Teams travelling from South and West can alight at Mangalore central/Junction railway station, move to State Bank bus stand (0.5 km from M'lore central and 5km from M'lore junction) and catch a bus to Udupi which is about 60 kms. There are plenty of buses plying from Mangalore to Udupi.

Transportation will be provided from Udupi railway station and Udupi bus stand. The teams are requested to inform of their ETA to either of the stations to the transportation officials in charge.

ACCOMODATION

The teams will be provided with unfurnished Rooms/Halls for their stay during the days of competitions. They have to pay a caution deposit of **Rs. 2000/-** which is refundable. We have very limited lodging facilities; hence the teams are requested to arrive at the venue of the tournament a day before the competition date and to leave the venue within 24 hours of completion of their competition.

RULES OF THE

TOURNAMENT

- 1. The Tournament shall be conducted as per the Rules of the Volleyball Federation of India.
- 2. All matches shall be played indoors on artificial surface. Therefore the teams are requested to ensure the players wear the appropriate footwear.
- 3. Each team shall pay the officiating fee of Rs. 1500 per match.
- 4. The teams shall report at least 30 mintues before the scheduled time of their match.
- 5. The teams shall provide the following documents for each of their players while registering:
 - (a) Eligibity form in quadruplicate duly signed by the competent authority.
 - (b) Attested copy of SSLC or any document as proof of date of birth
 - (b) Attested copy of PUC or equivalent / Degree certificates (in case of PG students).
 - (c) Copy of AADHAAR certificate
 - (e) Medical Fitness Certificate
- 6. All teams should participate with their university flag during the inaugural function.
- 7. The Organisers shall reserve the right to make changes in the schedule as they deem necessary.

- 1. There will be a Meeting of the Managers at Poornaprajna College, Udupi on January 3rd, 2023 at 4 pm.
- 2. The weather around this time of the year is plasant in the mornings and evenengs but warm during the day.
- 3. The participants are requested to bring blankets though basic facilities will be provided freely or on rent.
- 4. The participants are advised not to venture into the sea while visiting the beaches.


Wishing all the teams safe travel and best of luck

Udupi is situated about 55 km north of the educational, commercial and industrial hub of Mangalore and about 422 km west of state capital Bangalore by road. Udupi is one of the top tourist attractions in Karnataka and has various educational institutions. It is a pilgrimage centre notable for the Krishna Temple and is also known as the temple city. It also lends its name to the popular Udupi cuisine, is also known as Parashurama Kshetra], and is famous for Kanakana kindi. The sight seeing places in and around Udupi are:
