PROFILE

MANGALORE UNIVERSITY

Mangalore University is known for its rich heritage of Academic pursuits, Cultural and sports vibrancy and is one of the most sought after universities in India.

Mangalore University established in 1980, has its administrative and main campus of Post-Graduate Studies in Mangalagangothri. It is situated in an area of about 353 acres flanked by the Indian Ocean on one side and Western Ghats on the other. Mangalore University has grown impressively since its inception with 204 affiliated colleges, two constituent colleges (at Mangalore and Madikeri) and five autonomous colleges.

Mangalore University, since its inception in 1980, has continued its sports legacy throughout its existence. Beginning with Mrs. Vandana Rao who won three gold medals in All India Inter University competitions and went on to represent India in Olympics in 1984, to Mr. Dharun Ayyasamy representing India in the Olympics and setting a national record in 400 mts. hurdles, Mangalore University has produced a plethora of sports stars.

GOVERNMENT FIRST GRADE COLLEGE UPPINANGADY

Government First Grade College, Uppinangady is one of the oldest colleges in Dakshina kannada district established in the year 1982.

The college is situated on banks of River Nethravati in the cradle of beautiful nature, and near the National Highway. The campus of the college is spread over more than 10 acres of Government land and enjoys its own buildings and adequate infrastructure facilities. The college aims at providing higher education to the rural poor students of putturu taluq at affordable cost. Every year about 5 to 10% of the students pursue their higher education like M.A., M. Com., M.B.A., M.Sc. M.S.W

It is situated about 52 kms. from Mangalore in a lovely campus surrounded by lush green forest in the heartland of the town of Uppinangady.

VENUE AND DATE

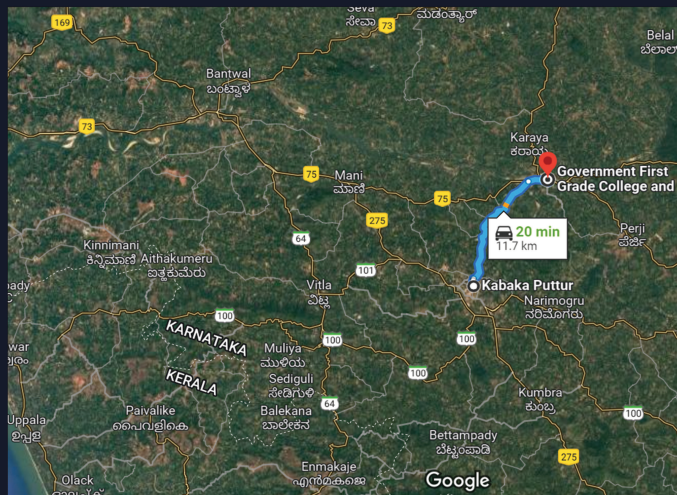
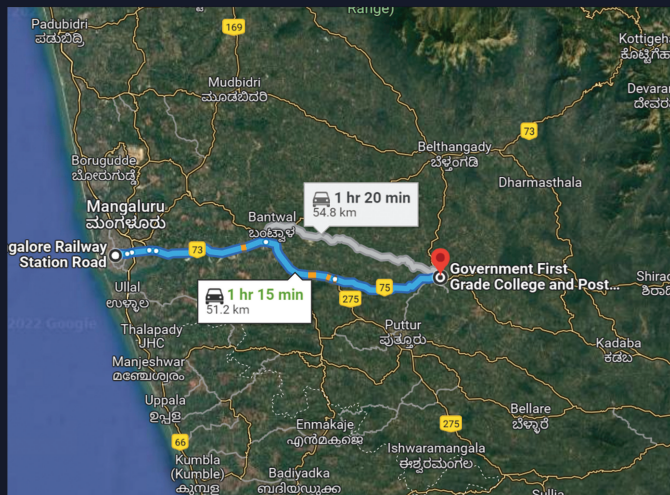
The tournament will be jointly organised with Government First Grade College, Uppinangady, Karnataka. The tournament will be conducted in the **College Sports Ground from January 13-17, 2023.**



Mangalore University is home to many Olympians such as Vandana Rao, Satish Rai, Dharun A, M R Poovamma, Hockey Internationals such as Ponnamma M N and Leelavathi M and former Kabaddi national team captain Mamatha Poojary.

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

Reaching the venue involves both train and bus travel. It can be approached in 2 ways:



Teams can alight at Mangalore Central / Junction railway station and move to the KSRTC bus terminal where they can board the bus to Uppinangady - distance is 52 kms. The route is Mangalore - B C Road - Mani - Uppinangady - Bangalore. Alternatively, teams can travel by Bangalore - Mangalore bus and alight at the venue.

Teams travelling from South can alight at Puttur (Kabaka) railway station and can get into busses moving towards Uppinangady. Puttur railway station is about 50 kms. from Mangalore on the Bangalore - Mangalore route. The distance from Kabaka Puttur to Uppinangady is about 12 kms.

Transportation will be provided on payment of nominal charges from Puttur Railway station only. The teams are requested to inform of their ETA to Puttur Railway station to the transportation officials in charge.

* Please note that there are no facilities for train reservation at the venue. Therefore ensure the booking of return journey in advance to avoid inconvenience.

ACCOMODATION

The teams will be provided with unfurnished Rooms/Halls for their stay during the days of competitions. They have to pay a caution deposit of **Rs. 2000/-** which is refundable. We have very limited lodging facilities; hence the teams are requested to arrive at the venue of the tournament a day before the competition date and to leave the venue within 24 hours of completion of their competition.

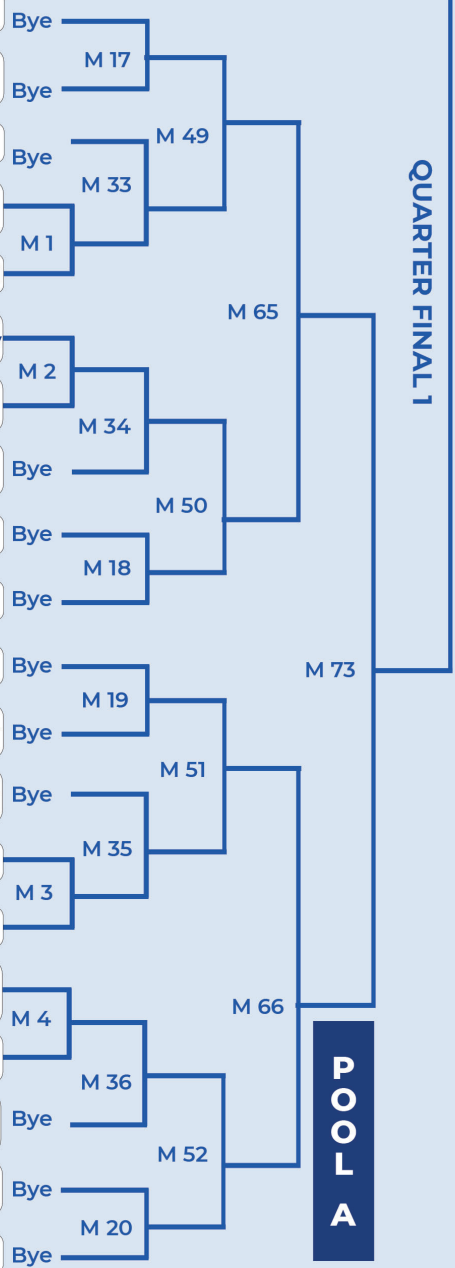

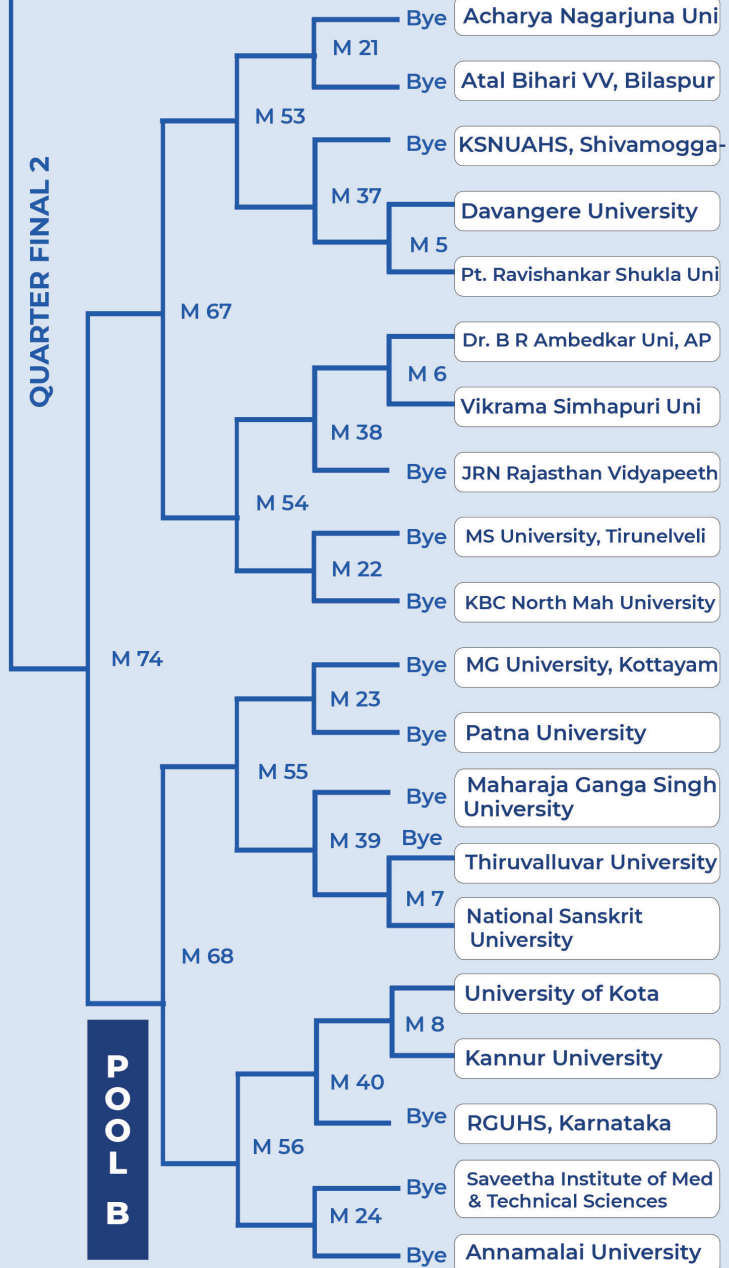

RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

1. The Tournament shall be conducted as per the Rules of the Ball Badminton Federation of India.
2. The match ball will be provided by the organisers and each team shall pay a match ball fee of Rs. 250 per match.
4. Each team shall pay the officiating fee of **Rs. 1500** per match.
5. The match ball fee and officiating fee shall be paid even for walkover matches.
6. The teams shall report at least 30 minutes before the match.
7. The teams shall provide the following documents for each of their players while registering:
 - (a) Eligibility form in quadruplicate duly signed by the competent authority.
 - (b) Attested copy of SSLC or any document as proof of date of birth
 - (b) Attested copy of PUC or equivalent / Degree certificates (in case of PG students).
 - (c) Copy of AADHAAR certificate
 - (e) Medical Fitness Certificate
 - (f) Receipt for Rs. 3000 paid via online to the AIU while reporting their teams.
8. All teams shall mandatorily participate in the march past with their university flag during the inaugural function.
9. The Organisers shall reserve the right to make changes in the schedule as they deem necessary.



INSTRUCTIONS

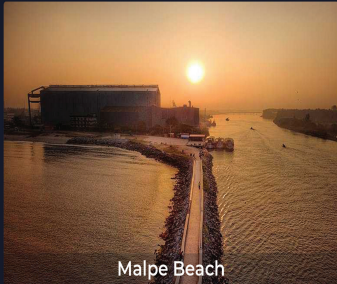
1. There will be a Meeting of the Managers at GFGC, Uppinangady on January 13th, 2023 at 11 am.

PLACES OF INTEREST

Uppinangady or Ubar is a town in the Dakshina Kannada district in the state of Karnataka. It is surrounded by the Kumaradhara River on one side and Nethravathi River on the other. When the town's two surrounding rivers rise during the rainy season and meet, this is called the "Sangam" which is a Sanskrit word for confluence.
